

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you all so much for your continued support.

In line with the recent increase in numbers of children attending school. Mrs Frost will now be required to teach in school, whilst Miss Smith continues to provide live lessons and remote learning.

1. There will be two daily live lessons English 9.45am, Maths 1.30pm. Each session will last for 30 minutes approximately.
2. There may not always be live lessons Friday. Work will be set and posted on the school website for that day if no live lessons are available.
3. Please do not allow your child to complete work set for a live lesson before your child has attended the lesson.
4. There will be two assignments set each week, one in English and one in maths. These will be set in assignments on teams and there will be brief feedback on each. This is optional.
5. There will be topic projects set on the school website for you to work on together. This term there will be Design and Technology followed by Science then History.
6. The school website also has links to some online books for your child to access. This can help them to continue their reading at home.
7. The Ruth Miskin phonics you tube channel also provides daily lessons for your children to access.
8. If you continue to run into technical difficulties please send us an email and we will do our best to support you in resolving any issues that we can.
9. At 3pm on Thursday there will be a story and catching up time with your child's class teacher.
10. If you feel your child would like more work, you can access Education City where there are fun activities and games to support your child's learning.
11. I will set up a folder for you to upload any other work your child has done in files on teams. Feedback will not be provided on this.
12. We are very pleased to see that the children have settled in very well to online learning and are very good at unmuting and muting their microphone as requested.
13. It is lovely to see so many of your children engaging fully in live lessons and having fun learning.
