Transport spotting

Go for a walk with your grown up, during your walk have a look for different types of transport. How many different types of transport can you see? Did you see any cars, bikes, trains, buses, or planes? How many of each mode of transport did you see? Did you see any others? What sounds do the cars make? What sound do the planes make? What other sounds can you hear?

What vehicles can you see in the picture below?

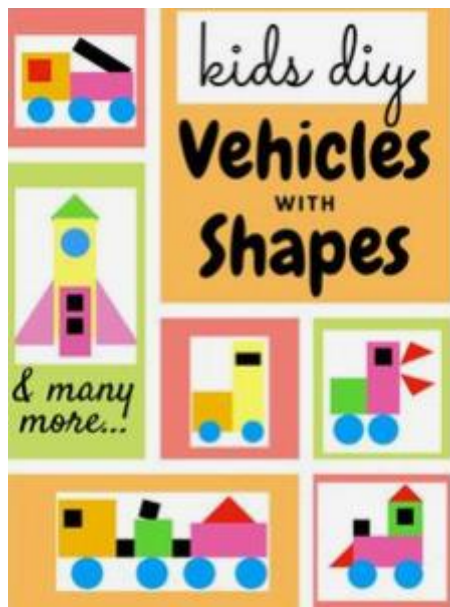
How many vehicles can you see?
