
Our topic for this half term is "The Great Fire of London".

#### **HISTORY**

# Great Fire of London



## Key Knowledge and Skills:

The lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national achievements such as Samuel Pepys and King Charles II.



We will be learning about effective searching on the internet using Purple Mash.

## Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know how to use the technology safely and respectfully.



#### **SCIENCE**

We are going to work scientifically to investigate everyday materials and whether they were suitable.

## Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know the names of different materials such as plastic, wood, metal, glass and know their different uses.





#### **ENGLISH**

## Writing

The book that we are focussing on is Dear Greenpeace. We are focussing on the skills of commas in a list, expanded noun phrases, exclamation marks and subordinating conjunctions (if, when, because and that).

We will know the structure of a finding tale and how to write a formal letter.

## Reading

We will be focusing on skills of retrieval and developing our vocabulary.

#### **MATHS**

As mathematicians we will be focusing on addition and subtraction using column method and to know how to exchanging.

Also, we will be exploring money and know the value of coins and notes up to five pounds

Finally, we will learning about multiplication and division and know how to use repeated addition, arrays, grouping and sharing.







## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We will be focussing on gymnastics, this will develop co-ordination and stability.

# Key Knowledge and Skills:

They will know how to make a sequence. Children will develop their fundamental movement skills become increasingly competent and confident and access a broad range of opportunities to extend their agility, balance and coordination, individually and with others.

#### **PSHE**

## Key Knowledge and Skills:

Recognise that they shouldn't judge people because they are different and we will know that everyone has differences and that make them special and unique.



#### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

We will be looking at the Jewish stories of Moses, which are also holy to Christians. We will explore the stories and teachings of inspirational people.

Also we will be focussing on Christmas around the world.

## Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know Jewish/ Christian stories such as Baby Moses, Burning Bush, Passover and Ten Commandments.

### **DESIGN TECHNOLOGY**

We will be creating 3D models of Tudor houses that will represent the scene from the Great Fire of London.

# Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know what a 3D structure model is. We will be using our designing, cutting, folding, measuring skills and we will evaluate our finished product. We will use our knowledge about the Great Fire of London to create our house.
