

Nursery Home Learning week beginning 18th May

Reading	<p>Read or watch 'Rumble in the Jungle.' https://youtu.be/D2-O1LkCzpM</p> <p>What animals can you see?</p> <p>Where do the animals live?</p> <p>Are there any rhyming words in the story? Ask an adult to write these down for you?</p>
Outdoor Learning Physical Development	<p>If you can go in the garden or for a walk, what can you use to help you make a collage or picture of your favourite character. Look out for twigs and sticks!</p> <p>Could you make an animal using leaves or draw an animal in the mud?</p> <p>Can you think of different ways to move like the animals in the story? Can you slither like a snake? Can you run like a lion? How do the other animals move?</p>
Mark Making	<p>Try and write your name on a piece of paper.</p> <p>Can you paint, draw, colour or make a collage of your favourite animal from 'Rumble in the Jungle.' (Could you use anything you have found outside to help you make your collage; twigs/grass etc)</p> <p>Animals live in different places around the world. Can you draw pictures of 2 animals you might find on a farm? Can you draw 2 animals you might find under the sea and 2 animals you might find in the jungle? How many animals have you drawn altogether?</p>
Maths	<p>Draw a long snake and a short snake. Draw 5 red circles on the short snake and 10 blue circles on the long snake.</p> <p>Which is the longest snake? Which is the shortest snake? How many circles does the short snake have? How many circles does the long snake have?</p>
Using Media and Materials	<p>Choose your favourite animal from the book and make a mask using cardboard (cereal box) or paper. Can you decorate your mask?</p> <p>Can you make any animals using blocks or construction toys?</p>
