As inventors we will be looking at boats and designing a boat that can carry passengers from the mainland to the island.

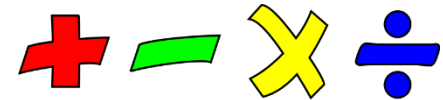
Homework Project
